

Northwest Calgary Ringette Society Jersey Deposit and Agreement

Players at U16 and U19 LEVELS are permitted to keep their NW Ringette Association jerseys with them personally during the season if this form is completed and submitted along with the deposit cheque. Jerseys are expensive to replace and we ask that you take exceptional care of them while in your possession.

Please note the NW Ringette policies related to Association jerseys:

- A Jersey deposit of \$200 per player is required prior to the first game.
- Association jerseys must be carried in a pillowcase to protect them in the equipment bag.
- During games, teams are required to wear the Association jerseys supplied by NW Ringette that display the colors and logo of the Association. Teams are not permitted to use an alternate jersey for any game. Exceptions will not be made if Association jerseys are forgotten at home.
- Jerseys are not to be worn during practices.
- Permanent alterations are not permitted on any Association jerseys (i.e., name bars, Captain or Assistant Captain letters etc). Tape is not to be used to create letters or numbers on Association jerseys.

It is advised to:

- Bring the Association jersey set (Home and Away jerseys) to each game
- Wash on a regular basis and hang to dry.
- Do not make any repairs.

Also note that Association jerseys are not permitted to be used for any off-ice activities such as bottle drives or team events.
